All Rangers in Angus are employed by ANGUSalive and figures are:

Chief Countryside Ranger -	1 FTE
Senior Countryside Ranger -	2 FTE
Countryside Ranger -	10 FTE
Total	13 FTE

We can confirm that we do not have a three-to-five year plan that we can provide.

However, the Ranger Service is currently part of our on-going Organisational Review, across all ANGUSalive service areas, as part of our Countryside Adventure service provision.
