I can provide the following information with regard to NHS Ayrshire and Arran.

NHS Ayrshire and Arran frequently look after patients in clinics who are suffering from hidradenitis suppurativa, covering a wide spectrum of severity. These patients will be seen by consultants, specialty doctors and nurse practitioners.

Patients are treated with topical antiseptics, antibiotics, retinoids and occasionally biologic agents or other anti-inflammatory treatments.

Patients are referred to general surgeons and plastic surgeons when necessary and are routinely advised on lifestyle issues affecting the disease when appropriate.
