To what extent does Aberdeen City Council provide a Named Person Service in all schools and other institutions.

A Named Person is made available to all children and families in schools. Parents have the right to deny the provision of a Named Person and this right is respected when requested and alternative arrangements made.

To what extent does Aberdeen City Council have an understanding of who has first aid skills in their area.

Aberdeen City Council keeps records of all staff who are first aid trained. Children and young people with first aid skills is not centrally recorded and schools do not routinely request that pupils help deliver first aid in schools.
